



Master Carpenter

Responsibilities: This position performs highly skilled rough and finish carpentry work in the construction, maintenance, alteration and repair of building components and structures at the campus under limited supervision. Responsible for completing large renovation projects and finished cabinetry work requiring fine carpentry skills. Duties require knowledge of the techniques and methods utilized in performing skilled finish carpentry work, the types uses of various materials used in the carpentry trade and knowledge and skill in the use of carpentry power tools and other related equipment used in the building trades, including set up, operation and maintenance of equipment. Knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions of the construction trades. Monday through Friday 7a.m. to 4p.m. Some nights and weekends may be required.

Minimum Qualifications: Associate's degree in a trade/technical field with up to and including four years' experience. Duties require knowledge of the techniques and methods utilized in performing skilled finish carpentry work, the types uses of various materials used in the carpentry trade and knowledge and skill in the use of carpentry power tools and other related equipment used in the building trades, including set up, operation and maintenance of equipment. Knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions of the construction trades, including safeguards required and safe work practices are essential in performing the duties of the position. Applicants with an equivalent combination of education and experience will be considered.
